



## **Notification Note on COVID-19 Situational Update**

The total laboratory tests conducted within twenty-four hours are 943; of this one (1) of them is confirmed positive for COVID-19 and the total confirmed cases as of today are 124. The tests were conducted by The Ethiopian Public Health Institute, National Animal Health Diagnostic and Investigation Center, Armauer Hansen Research Institute, Ethiopian Biotechnology Institute, Adama Public Health Research and Referral Laboratory, Amhara Public Health Institute and Jigjiga University laboratory. Furthermore, nine people (8 from Addis Ababa and 1 from Bahir Dar) recovered from the disease that makes the total number of recoveries fifty (50). The Details of the case are presented below;

Nevertheless, the result did not affirm that the outbreak is over in our country rather it shows those who are detected and tested are negative.
